Our dear and well Esteemed friend Elizabeth Gidley was born in Dartmouth on the first day of the first month 1702 of honest Parents, tho' not of high Esteem in the world, nor in Society with friends, Divine wisdom Seeing meet to Call her forth as from the highways and hedges with a power of Compassive Love, into the work and Service of the Ministry About the year 1740. And altho' she offer'd up her Natural Life (as she saith) if it might be accepted, rather than be thus Exposed in the View of the world. Yet (she saith) her Chosen be- loved deall Tenderly with her, and made her sensible that pure obedience and Submission to his Will whether in life or death was her duty, and that the fear of man was a snare. Thus she Gave up to that Divine Hand that had Called her forth out of Egyptian Darkness into his Marvellous Light, and by a gradual Advancement in that Service became a skilful and lively Minister of the Word amongst us, to the Edification and Comfort of many; And altho' she was not furnished like unto many with human parts or Literatures, yet these defects were abundantly supply'd with Divine Wisdom, even to the wonder of those that knew her-

The place of her abode was in our Town of Dartmouth the whole Course of her time, with whom we had true Unity, both as a Member and a Minister, in both which Capacities she was truly Serviceable among us, being a woman of a Pious and Exemplary life, her Conversation Corresponding with her Publick Testimony, and as she was Remarkable for her Innocency, Humility and self denial, so she seemed far from Affectation in Speech, Behaviour and Apparel, Living up herself to the doctrine she Preached to others, and was able from her own Experience (to speak a word in season) to direct others in the way that lead out of the Bondage of Sin & Evil into the glorious Liberty and freedom of the Truth

She was diligent in attending our Religious meetings when opportunity would allow, being

Under Extreame difficulty on the account of her Husband as she has hinted in a Manuscript which she wrote a little before her death) And as through divine assistance she surmounted the Greatest Trials with uncommon Valour and fortitude, so she often directed others to the same kind of help which was able to Support them in the Greatest Struggles frequently Encouraging friends to faithfulness in Every branch of their Testimony, and oft was she Engaged to Call particularly to the youth in an Awful and fervent Manner to forsake their wickedness and Vanity, and Consider their latter End in the days of their youth, and prepare for that Tremendous Period of time that is hastning upon all flesh;

She was taken so ill About four Months before her death with a disorder in her Throat, which Gradually increasing Upon her soon Confined her at home, in which time she wrote the afore mentioned Manuscript, and finished it but a little before her death, her Illness often being Very painful and bodily Affliction Great, which she bore with Exemplary patience and Resignation, as death to her seemed to be no Terror, her Under- standing and Memory was preserved to the last, she departed this life the 29th of the Eleventh Month 1765 in the 64th year of her Age, and was buried in friends burying yard at Donaganset, was a Minister about 25 years, and as her Removal is our Great Loss, so we believe it is her Greater Gain, having no doubt through many Tribulations Entered into that glorious Kingdom of Joy and peace, where the wicked cease from Troubling, and where the weary be at Rest
