Considerable property located in **New Bedford** is disposed of under the will of **David H. Potter**, late of **Westport**, which has been filed here. **Mr. Potter** makes a gift of \$500 to be applied for holding revival or special evangelistic services through the monthly meeting of the Society of Friends of **Dartmouth**. Other bequests are the following;

To his son, **Robert H. Potter**, he leaves the homestead farm in **Westport**, with the direction that testator's wife, **Sarah F. Potter**, shall be permitted to occupy part of the house for her life, and be supplied with firewood and supplies of fruit and vegetables. Provision is made that, if his son, **Robert**, and his widow should desire to sell the homestead, they are to seek the advice of two Friends as to their course; and they are requested to act in accordance with advice so given.

If such a sale shall be made, **Mr. Potter** directs that all or part of the proceeds shall be invested in a home for the widow and son, in a location agreeable to both of them. To his son **Robert** he also gives such bank deposits as he may have in the **Fair-**

haven Institution for Savings, absolutely.

To his son, **Abram J. Potter**, and the latter's wife, **Jennie**, and to the survivors of these two, he wills all his real estate in **Central Village** for their life use. He directs that if **Abram** and **Jennie** wish to sell the property they shall seek the advice of two Friends, and act in accordance with counsel given by them; and that part of the proceeds of such sale be applied to the purchase of a home for them. On the death of the survivor of these two, the property mentioned in this item of the will is to go to the lineal descendants of **Abram** and **Jennie**, by right of representation. He also gives to his son **Abram** all his money on deposit in the **New Bedford** Institution for Savings, absolutely, and all his carpenter's tools except those that are duplicates of what **Abram** now has. The duplicate tools are to go to **Robert**.

Isaac H. Potter, a third son, and the latter's wife, **Edith**, are to have the life use of his house and lot on **Pierce street, New Bedford**, with provision identical with that in the bequests to the other sons, in respect to possible sale of the property. On the death of **Isaac** and **Edith**, the estate is to be divided equally among their children; or, if no children survive them, it is to be distributed among testator's grandchildren, share and share alike. **Isaac** also is to receive in fee, testator's deposits in the Union Savings bank in **Fall River**, and the paint shop on **Pierce street, New Bedford**.

To his wife, **Sarah F. Potter**, he gives, absolutely, all his money in the Citizens' Savings bank of **Fall River**; 13 shares in the **Fairhaven** National bank, and all his money in the **Fall River** National bank.

He directs that \$200 shall be paid to each of his grandchildren, when they become 18[?] years of age. He gives to his wife and son, **Robert**,

the use of the furniture and household effects at the homestead until the death of the wife, and provides that after her death division shall be made thereof equally among his three sons, or the survivors of them.
